Protection status S – Changes from 1 November 2025

- <u>Nothing</u> will change for persons who already hold protection status S.
 Protection status S <u>will not be revoked before 4 March 2027</u>, unless there is a lasting improvement in the situation in Ukraine before then.
- Decisions on <u>new</u> and <u>pending</u> applications will now be made on the basis of the region of Ukraine in which the applicant last lived.
 - Persons who come from a region to which they can reasonably be expected to return will <u>no longer</u> be granted protection status S.
 - SEM will determine which regions are considered safe for return. The list will be reviewed at regular intervals and updated as necessary.
 - The changes apply to all <u>decisions</u> on protection reached by SEM from 1 November.
 - For persons already in Switzerland with protection status S, the region of Ukraine in which they last resided will not be a deciding factor if they wish to bring their immediate family to Switzerland after 1 November.
- No one will be sent back to Ukraine if they are at risk of physical harm, regardless of the region in which they last resided.
